• **Thursday, March 9 – Speed Mentoring at regional high schools** Facilitated by the US Coast Guard, speed mentoring opportunities are offered to the area high schools, where industry professionals start the framework for mentor-mentee relationships with quick one-on-one mentoring sessions.

SETX Women in Industry, a newly formed 501(c)(3) organization, will be coordinating the events. All proceeds from this week will benefit scholarships for female students going into the industrial workforce, with the sponsor playing a key role in the allocation of those funds.
